Full Paper Submission Guidelines and Procedure

1. Eligibility for Full Paper Submission

- Only authors whose **abstracts are accepted** for presentation (oral or poster) are invited to submit full papers.
- Papers should be **original and unpublished**, representing **innovative research**, **policy frameworks**, **or field applications** relevant to the Summit themes:
 - 1. Digital and Intelligent Systems for River Management
 - 2. Climate Change, Water Security, and Resilience
 - 3. Sustainable Agriculture and Horticulture
 - 4. Policy, Governance, and Transboundary Cooperation
 - 5. Community, Innovation, and Education

2. Paper Structure and Format

File Format:

- Submit as a Word Document (.doc / .docx)
- File name: FullPaper_FirstAuthorName.docx (Example: FullPaper_Gupta.docx)

Manuscript Layout:

Section Details

Title Centered, bold, font size 14

Author(s) and Affiliations Full name(s), institution(s), country, and corresponding author email

Abstract 200–300 words summary Keywords 3–5 relevant keywords

Introduction Background, significance, and objectives

Materials and Methods Description of study area, data, and analytical tools
Results and Discussion Data analysis, findings, and interpretation and figures

Conclusion Key insights and policy implications
References APA format (consistency required)

Formatting Details:

• Font: Times New Roman

Font Size: 12 ptLine Spacing: 1.5

• Margins: 1 inch on all sides

Maximum Length: 8–10 pages (including figures and tables)



3. Figures, Tables, and Equations

- Figures and tables should be numbered sequentially and captioned clearly.
- Equations must be formatted using the Word equation editor.
- Images must be in high-resolution (300 dpi) format.

4. Submission Procedure

- 1. Prepare the full paper following the guidelines above.
- 2. Attach your paper to an email with the subject line:
 - "Full Paper Submission [Author Name] [Theme Title]"
- 3. Email to:

- 4. Attach proof of **registration fee payment** along with the submission.

5. Review and Publication

- All papers will undergo peer review by the Technical and Editorial Committee.
- Accepted papers will be published in the **Conference Proceedings** and considered for inclusion in:
 - o International Journal of Cognitive Sciences, AI, Computing and Modeling (IJCSACM)-Online, or any other journal with publishing partners
 - o IRBF Working Papers Series
 - o Special Issue on "Intelligent River Systems and Climate Resilience"
- Selected papers may also be recommended for **Scopus/UGC-approved journals** (upon author consent).

Guidelines for Online Poster Presentation

1. Overview

The **Online Poster Presentation** segment of the *International River Summit 2025* provides an interactive platform for **researchers, students, innovators, and practitioners** to share their work on sustainable river basin management, intelligent technologies, and climate resilience.

This online mode ensures **global participation** and encourages innovative visual communication of ideas, models, and findings relevant to the Summit's five themes:

- 1. Digital and Intelligent Systems for River Management
- 2. Climate Change, Water Security, and Resilience
- 3. Sustainable Agriculture and Horticulture
- 4. Policy, Governance, and Transboundary Cooperation
- 5. Community, Innovation, and Education

2. Poster Preparation Guidelines

File Format and Size

- Posters must be submitted in **PDF** (**preferred**) or **JPEG/PNG** format.
- Orientation: Landscape (Horizontal)
- Size: A1 (841 mm × 594 mm) or 16:9 ratio (for screen display)
- File size should not exceed **10 MB**.
- Filename: Poster_AuthorName_Themecode.pdf (Example: Poster_Sharma_DIM.pdf)

Design & Layout Recommendations

- Font: Clear sans-serif font (Arial, Calibri, or Open Sans)
- Font Size: Minimum 20 pt for readability.
- Include the following sections clearly:
 - 1. **Title** (bold and prominent)
 - 2. Author(s) and Affiliation(s)
 - 3. Introduction / Background
 - 4. Objectives
 - 5. Methodology / Approach
 - 6. Key Results / Findings
 - 7. Conclusion / Recommendations
 - 8. Acknowledgment and Contact Information

Visual Elements

- Use diagrams, charts, maps, infographics, and photographs to enhance clarity.
- Maintain a balance between text and visuals (ideally 40% text -60% visuals).
- Keep design minimal, consistent, and professional use pastel or summit theme colors.



3. Submission Procedure

- 1. Prepare your poster following the format above.
- 2. Save the file with your name and theme.
- 3. Submit via email to:

- 4. or upload through the **Official Poster Submission Google Form** (available on https://www.rwua.org.in).
- 5. Include the following details in your email body:
 - o Full Name
 - o Institution / Organization
 - Poster Title
 - Theme Category
 - o Mode of Presentation (Online / Offline)
 - Registration ID

4. Evaluation Criteria

All posters will be evaluated by the **Scientific and Evaluation Committee** based on:

- Relevance to conference themes
- Originality and innovation
- Clarity and visual presentation
- Technical or scientific content
- Policy or practical applicability

5. Awards and Recognition

- Best Online Poster Award in each theme category.
- Certificates for all accepted posters.
- Selected posters will be featured in the Summit Proceedings and on the WCPI website.
