This initiative bridges the gap between **academic research and public understanding** by transforming technical content into concise, engaging, and accessible formats. Each selected paper and presentation will be archived for long-term reference and global dissemination.

## **About the WCPI Knowledge Library**

The WCPI Knowledge Library is a digital repository designed to preserve and share the collective intellectual contributions from global professionals, scientists, and industry leaders. Through multimedia formats — including videos, podcasts, and infographics — it enhances the visibility and accessibility of scientific knowledge beyond traditional publications.

## **Publication Components**

#### 1. PowerPoint Presentation Repository:

- o Authors' presentation slides (in PDF or PPT format) will be curated and hosted with proper metadata (title, authors, affiliation, and keywords).
- Each presentation will be given a unique digital identifier (WCPI ID) for easy citation and reference.

## 2. Podcast Summary of Full Paper:

- Authors will provide a 2–3 minute recorded summary (or written abstract converted into a narrated audio podcast).
- These podcasts will summarize key insights, findings, and recommendations from the full papers.
- Hosted on the WCPI Podcast Channel and linked to the corresponding full paper or proceedings.

#### **Process and Author Instructions**

- Authors of accepted full papers will be invited to submit:
  - 1. A 10–12 slide PowerPoint presentation (summary of their paper).
  - 2. A 2–3 minute audio summary (MP3/WAV format) or a short video narration (optional).
- Submissions will be reviewed for clarity and quality by the WCPI Editorial Board.
- Final approved materials will be uploaded to the **WCPI Digital Library** and made publicly accessible under a **Creative Commons license** (**CC BY-NC 4.0**).
